

Assemble most of the Wave Port and hinges while on land, including attaching any accessories (see **Attach Post Attachments to Wave Port Instructions**). If the posts are already anchored into the lake then you may slide the post attachments over the posts and then connect to the port while on the water.

Bow Stop

1. Attach the bow stop to the front end of the Wave Port with 4 bolts and washers and tighten into the threaded inserts in the Wave Port decking.



2. Attach the D-Ring to the top of the Bow Stop using the $\frac{1}{4}$ x $\frac{1}{2}$ " bolts and tightening securely.



Roller maintenance on Ports

1. If it is difficult to launch or park the watercraft on the Wave Port the rollers should be lubricated with a light oil, silicone spray or silicone and Teflon spray. A food grade lubricant would be preferred but is not necessary. A spray on, non-stick cooking oil, such as Pam, may be used as well. Reapply as needed to keep the rollers operating smoothly.
